Participant Disciplinary Guidelines

The 2009 IIHF Hockey Development Camp promotes the vision of partnership for progress, people coming together and learning from each other. The aim is to develop both hockey Skills and life skills of the participants, and emphasises “Fair Play and Respect” both on and off the ice.

All participants must agree to follow these guidelines during the Camp.

On-Ice Rules

- The on-ice practice rules are the responsibility of the Team Coaches
- Players must obey these rules and guidelines
- The on-ice game rules are enforced by the Game Officials, as per Hockey Development Camp Game Protocol and the IIHF 2006-2010 Rule Book

Off-Ice Camp Rules

- No Changing of Hotel Room Assignments
- No Alcohol or Drugs
- No Smoking or Chewing Tobacco
- No Gambling for money
- No Pornography
- No Theft
- No Vandalism
- No Outside Visitors in Hotel Rooms
- Room Curfews must be followed!!!
- All Room Services and bills are the responsibility of the person and must be paid before leaving
- Punctuality, being on time
- Cleanliness
- Camp Rules, mobile phones during meals etc.
- Respect all Persons and Property

Sanctions

- The sanctions are based on levels of severity
- The following are some examples of sanctions that may be implemented:
 - Warning given by Team Staff and NA Team Staff
 - Individual Meeting
 - Referral to Camp Directorate
 - Single Game Suspension
 - Multiple Game Suspension
 - Sent Home
 - Additional Suspension by National Association
