All National Associations can nominate and send one National Association Learn to Play Instructor to participate in the instructor Seminar being operated during this camp. The National Association Instructor will be the person responsible, within their National Association, for delivery of the Learn to Play coach education program and beginner player program. They will be actively involved in the promotion and distribution of information and programs relating to Learn to Play.

### The Seminar program will include:

- Introduction of the IIHF National Association Development Assistance Program
- Introduction and review of the IIHF Introduction to Coaching and Learn to Play Programs
- Development new sections for the programs
- Development of a drill bank
- Filming of video clips to compliment program and Manuals
- Operation of IIHF Introduction to Coaching Seminar
- Use of the IIHF Learn to Play Lesson Manual
- Organisation and operation of Learn to Play jamborees and on-ice practices

### Role

During the Camp you will participate in classroom sessions, where you will become familiar with the LTP Program and IIHF coach education material. You will also be expected to prepare presentations for the other people participating in the workshop.

Theory meetings for players, analysing practices / games and presentation for other coaches are also included into the program.

### Equipment

We encourage you to bring your skates, gloves and tracksuit as well as your off-ice training gear to camp. The IIHF can supply helmets and sticks to each in Vierumäki.
